JOURNEY TO US

The thermal spa capital of Fürstenfeld is located in the heart of the thermal spa and volcano region of Styria.

By car and bus: from the north, west and south via the A2 motorway and the S7, from the east via the S7, Fürstenfeld exit.

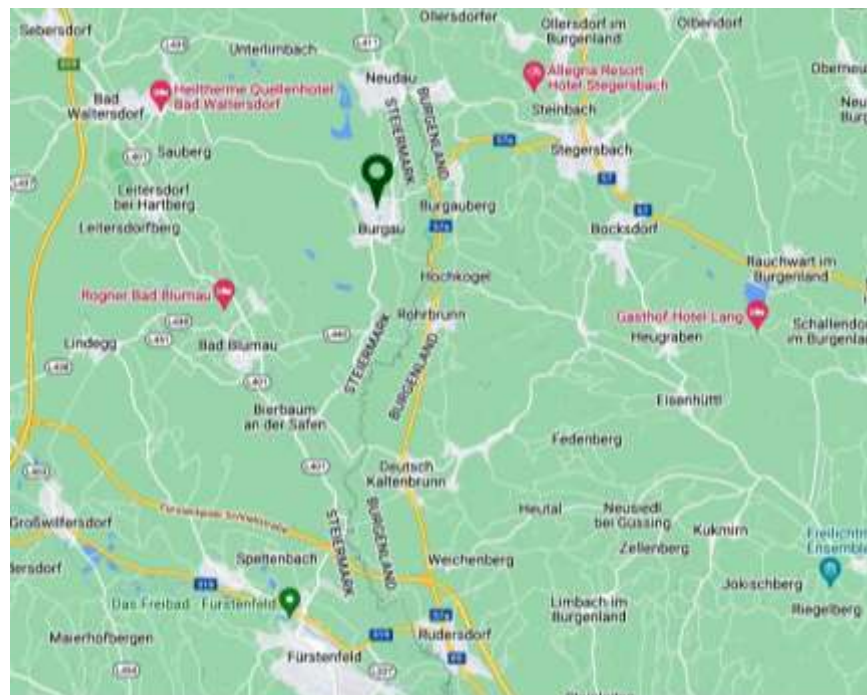
By public transport: take the regional railway to Fürstenfeld station.



The market town of Burgau is located in the Lafnitz Valley near the border to Burgenland, approx. 15 km north of Fürstenfeld.

By car and bus: travelling from the west and south via the A2 and the S7, from the east via the S7, exit Fürstenfeld. Continue via Bierbaum to Burgau. From the north via the A2 motorway, exit Bad Waltersdorf. Continue via Bad Waltersdorf and Bad Blumau to Burgau

Public: with RegioBus 485 from Fürstenfeld or Hartberg - only on weekdays. No bus connection to Burgau at weekends!



PARKING

Distance from Parking to Competition Centre: approx. 700 m

Sprint:

Car park instructions starting from the junction of the L 411 and L 402 in the north of Burgau (at the Spar market).

GPS: 47.148986077, 16.1022609075

Parking only in the north-eastern industrial estate and on Angerackerweg to the east of it, in each case from north to south according to the signposts. Any parking without a signpost (including at Spar Markt and urban area) is prohibited and leads to disqualification.

The route to the Competition Centre leads along the road in the industrial estate or the Angerackerweg to the south, then along the Autalweg to the L 402, which is crossed (take care!), then along the sports field to the WKZ in the Schlossbad - marked.

Distance from Parking to Competition Centre: 300 – 900 m

Long Distance:

Free choice of parking in the Burgau area, preferably along the main road and in the industrial estate to the east of it (same parking situation as on 8 June, but no instruction). On Sunday, the car park at the Spar supermarket can also be used. We do not recommend using the car parks at the castle and Schlossbad, as they are partially restricted to organisation and infrastructure.

Elongated, relatively narrow forest area on the slope from the hill country to the Feistritz valley. Mid-steep terrain with several deeply incised side valleys. Predominantly mixed forest with dense network of paths.

The sprint area is characterised by the castle with surrounding parkland and the market town of Burgau (closed town centre, residential and commercial areas).

The main square and through road (Herrengasse) are closed to through traffic, the side streets are all 30 km/h zones and generally have little, but still some traffic. The road traffic regulations must be observed.

There are a number of restricted areas - these are marked on the map and in the terrain. Non-compliance leads to disqualification - controls!

Large closed forest area with only slight differences in altitude. Predominantly mixed forest that is used for forestry with varying degrees of intensity, dense network of paths. Completely new (smaller) clear-cuts as well as new harvester and tractor tracks may be missing from the map. Partly relatively dense undergrowth, often high grass, making smaller paths often difficult to see. High blueberry bushes, especially in the northern part of the map. Clearcuts partly overgrown with thorny undergrowth, as well as nettles along the channels.

The partly marshy ground has created ideal conditions for the development of a considerable wild boar population, whose tracks are clearly visible throughout the woodland.

Please do not enter the marked restricted area!

START AND FINISH

Relay:

Start and Finish near Competition Centre (Outdoor Swimming Pool Fürstenfeld)

Distance from Parking to CC: approx. 700 m

Sprint:

Start and Finish near Competition Centre (Outdoor Castle Pool Burgau)

Distance from Parking to CC: 300 – 900 m. Only the marked route may be used, the urban area (with the exception of the main road) is a restricted area from 8.00 on the day of the competition.

Attention: Quarantine for categories MW -16E, MW -18E, MW -20E, MW21E from 14:00, last entry 14:30 - warm-up area and WCs available.

Runners in the specified categories will be directed from the car park towards the CC directly to the quarantine and are not allowed to go to the CC. Bib numbers and wristbands for entry to the pool area for these runners are only available in the quarantine area. Please observe the barriers and signs - the football ground is a restricted area and may not be entered. We expect compliance with the fair play rules.

Distance from quarantine to the start: 750 m, warm-up map along the route to the start.

All other categories start directly at the CC (100 m).

Long Distance

Distance to the start: 2,000 m. Mobile toilets and water available near the start.

2 finishes - dislocated finish 1 for all categories except MW21E – route from finish to CC approx. 750 m, marked. Do not forget to read out in the CC!

Finish 2 for MW21E at Castle Pool Burgau. Please observe general traffic regulations in the urban area.

- ▲ The event will be organised according to the valid rules of the competition regulations of the Austrian Federation.
- ▲ WRE: the IOF rules also apply superordinately to categories M/W21E.
- ▲ The organising club accepts no liability whatsoever for any damage that may occur, not even to third parties. Every runner starts at his/her own risk.
- ▲ Training is prohibited in the running areas until the competition (moving with a map).
